User Guide to the Certification Package

Once you have purchased your equality policies Certification Package online.

C2E will contact you by email to arrange your assessment.

You will be sent the Pre-Assessment guide and provided with Access to and use of online resources.

Before the assessment can commence you will be required to email a copy of all your current policies to your C2E assessor.

The assessor will review the policies that you have provided. You will be given a Full Assessment, Report and Recommendations covering Equality Policy Areas.

Where the assessor indicates that a policy is missing or reguires more detail, the organisation must confirm that it will correct this.

Confirmation must be provided by email to assessors within 10 working days so that they can finalise their recommendations.

The assessor will complete their assessment and recommend if the organisation is to be awarded a certificate based on the evidence presented and the statements of assurance from the organisation.

The assessor will notify the organisation by email of their recommendations.



Successful organisations will receive the Equality Policies Verification Certificate. Successful results will be published on the Equality Register
